## PREVENTION OF MOSQUITO BREEDING

Recently, we received feedback that residents were bitten by mosquitoes at night within their units. In addition to the twice-weekly fogging carried out by our Pest Control contractor, M/s ANTICIMEX PEST MANAGEMENT PTE. LTD, the Management is working closely with the cleaners and gardeners to carry out regular inspection at the common area to eradicate the possible breeding source.

We want to urge all residents to take measures to prevent the breeding of mosquitoes within the units. Therefore, residents need to take immediate action to clear stagnant water from habitats in their homes and to perform the daily 10-minute Mozzie Wipeout to ensure water is not stagnating in pails, vases, containers etc. Residents must remove all those items placed at the air-cond ledge that may be potential mosquito breeding places.

<b>1</b> Change water in vases on alternate days.	<b>2</b> Remove water from flowerpot plates on alternate days.	<b>3</b> Turn over all pails and water storage containers.
