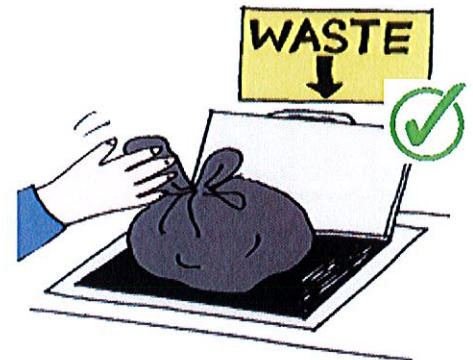

## Proper Disposal of Rubbish in Bin Chutes

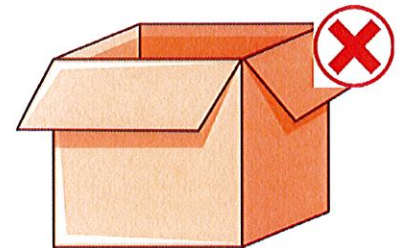
We would like to highlight that inconsiderate disposal of rubbish through the rubbish chutes can cause:

- 1) **CHOKED** bin chutes – if bulky items are thrown in
  - 2) **FIRE HAZARD** (potential) – if easily combustible items e.g. newspapers are thrown in
  - 3) **PERSONAL INJURY** – if broken glass and sharp objects are thrown in
  - 4) **DAMAGE** to bin containers – if heavy items are thrown in
- FOUL SMELLS & ATTRACT PESTS** – if loose/wet kitchen food waste not properly sealed



We seek every resident's co-operation to dispose only small items through the unit internal bin chute.

Large rubbish which are recyclable such as carton boxes, stacks of newspaper, please dispose it neatly at the recycle bins area (substation in front of Tower A).



For non-recycle large items such as furniture, electronic items, please make the necessary arrangements for a contractor to dispose it accordingly outside of the premise.
