### SHUTDOWN OF PNEUMATIC SYSTEM – MAJOR CHOKE

We would like to inform you that the pneumatic system has to be **shut down with immediate effect until further notice**. We are working with the vendor on the recovery process but have been told that this can take from 1 day to more than a month depending on the method require to rectify the system.

The vendor has found a metal rod wedge at a bend in the main pipe located near Block 79. This has caused a backlog of rubbish to accumulate up the sub pipe at each block. When this happen, it not only cost the estate money to clear the choke, but it also caused inconvenience to residents as well as foul smell can be emitted due to rotting rubbish stuck in the pipe.

We would like to urge all residents, to bring their own rubbish down and throw into the Green Bins located at the basement carpark until the system is operational again.
